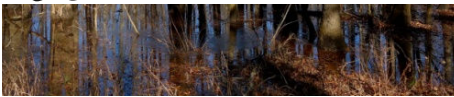

Directions to My Father's House

Make a Right onto "Believeth Blvd."
 Keep straight and go through the Green Light, which is Jesus Christ.
